It is a structural project aimed at supporting the reform and modernization process of the higher education systems in Morocco and Tunisia, in order to **contribute to improve the quality and relevance of the academic supply, in line with the labour market needs**, and to foster graduates employability in both countries. The competences transfer realized in favor of statisticians, IT and administrative staff from the beneficiary universities allowed to build-up a web platform matching supply of and demand for qualified labour and to **institutionalize the monitoring of students paths and graduates professional trajectories**.



- Specific objectives**
- To provide universities with information on the efficacy of the academic supply given to students so to adapt it to the competences required by firms
 - To support students and graduates in their search for internships and job opportunities and to support firms in the identification of the best candidates to be hired, thanks to a web platform matching supply of and demand for qualified labour
 - To create a local observatory on labour market at each partner university level and two national observatories in Morocco and Tunisia
 - To run statistical surveys on graduates tracking in Morocco and Tunisia



- Key results**
- 23.345 students and 38 firms registered on the web platform
 - 2 national reports on socioeconomic contexts in both countries
 - 55 statisticians, IT and administrative staff trained
 - 11 local observatories and 2 national observatories on labour market created
 - 1 report on the measures to foster interaction with alumni associations produced
 - 1 report on firms' competence needs and 1 report on the measures to promote internships produced
 - 1 methodological guidelines for the future development of graduates surveys elaborated
 - 2 project sustainability plans drafted
